BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego encourages the University Medical Center to provide access to the parking garage via Hotel Circle and Mission Valley, as well as the existing access via Dickinson and Washington Streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego understands that the University Medical Center will comply with all local, state and federal laws regarding the construction of this garage and new access road.
