

RESOLUTION NO. R-257238Adopted on SEP 28 1982

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

Alison M. Gonzales Nancy L. Kaiser	Planning Risk Management	\$120	Ms. Kaiser was an Administrative Aide I at the time she submitted this suggestion. She suggested that the format of the Historical Site Board minutes be revised. This is expected to save \$395 in the first year in labor costs. Since this idea was similar to Alison Gonzales' earlier suggestion which applied to the Community Planners Committee meetings, the Suggestion Awards Committee decided to split the award equally between the two suggesters.
Roy C. Wamback	General Services	\$ 30	Mr. Wamback is a Custodian II in the Buildings Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$45 for his suggestion to purchase coveralls and towels and launder them in-house. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$731. This is the remainder of his award.
Jessiemay Faith	Library	\$ 25	Ms. Faith is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that a rubber stamp be used to identify discarded books. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Richard L. Boles	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Boles is an Airport Operations Assistant in the Airports Division. He suggested that a berm in the Brown Field parking lot be painted with reflective paint. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
