WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the alley to be vacated will continue to have access; NOW, THEREFORE,

1. That the alley adjacent to Lots 3-9 and 14-20 in Block 17, of Sorrento Lands and Townsite Subdivision, Map 483, as more particularly shown on Drawing NO. 15749-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-257536, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.




