AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, MAY 3, 1983.

WHEREAS, Pete Wilson, Mayor of The City of San Diego, has been elected to the United States Senate thereby creating a vacancy in the office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that in the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of the Mayor the Council shall have authority to fill such vacancy by appointment but in the event the Council shall fail to fill such vacancy by appointment within thirty (30) days after the vacancy, the Council must immediately cause an election to be held to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on November 15, 1982 adopted Resolution No. R-257474 declaring its intention to call Special Municipal Elections to be held on March 15, 1983 and, if needed, on May 3, 1983, to fill said vacancy by election; and

WHEREAS, the Charter provides that at said election a person shall be elected to serve for the remainder of such unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on January 3, 1983 adopted Ordinance No. O-15882 (New Series) calling a Special Municipal Election to be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, March

15, 1983 for the purpose of electing a Mayor to fill the unexpired term of Pete Wilson; and

WHEREAS, said Special Municipal Election was held in the City of San Diego on March 15, 1983 and no person received a majority of all the votes cast and since no person was elected, it is necessary to call a Special Municipal Election to be held on May 3, 1983 to fill such vacancy by election from among the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, May 3, 1983, for the purpose of electing a Mayor to fill the unexpired term of Pete Wilson.

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 4. That the polls for said elections shall be open

from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 3, 1983.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 6. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Judges and Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 8. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
