## EXHIBIT A PARCEL 7 (Mission Bay Park)

All those portions of Pueblo Lots 205 and 212 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof made by James Pascoe in 1870, a copy of which Map was filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, November 14, 1921, as Miscellaneous Map No. 36, more particularly described in Parcels 1 and 2 as follows:

- 1. Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly line of Block 28, Ocean Beach Park Annex, according to Map thereof No. 1217, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, October 23, 1909, with the Southeasterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard, as located and established as of the date of this instrument; thence along said Northerly line of Block 28, being also the Mean High Tide Line of Mission Bay per San Diego City Engineering Department Drawing 13389-D, as follows: South 64°50'24" East, 20.30 feet; South 78°46'03" East, 355.07 feet; North 86°15'50" East, 576.20 feet; North 81°03'01" East, 177.08 feet; North 71°'14'47" East, 315.46 feet; North 80°53'48" East, 80.82 feet to the Northeasterly corner of Lot 66 of said Block 28; thence leaving said Block 28 but continuing along said Mean High Tide Line, North 73°47'02" East, 50.01 feet; thence South 88°40'48" East, 57.68 feet to a point herein designated as Point "A", being a point on the Westerly line of Nimitz Boulevard, as said street is located and established as of the date of this instrument; thence along said Westerly line of Nimitz Boulevard, North 21°14'17" West, 869.40 feet to the intersection with the Southeasterly line of said Sunset Cliffs Boulevard; thence along said Southeasterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard as follows: South 61°50'12" West, 784.66 feet to the beginning of a tangent 1,450.00-foot radius curve, concave Southeasterly; Southwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 25°45'45", an arc length of 651.98 feet; South 39°23'33" West, 167.73 feet returning to the Point of Beginning.
