AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3 OF
THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION
63.02.8 RELATING TO GLASS CONTAINERS, LITTERING,
PROHIBITED IN CITY PARKS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 3 of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section
63.02.8 to read as follows:

SEC. 63.02.8 SAME--GLASS CONTAINERS, LITTERING, PROHIBITED


(a) To have, possess or use any cup, tumbler, jar or
container made of glass and used for carrying or containing
any liquid for drinking purposes, except in locations where
such containers are permitted under the terms of a lease,
operating agreement or permit.

(b) To leave or scatter about any boxes, empty or
otherwise, waste paper, remains of lunches, newspaper or
rubbish of any kind, except that such material and matter
may be left and deposited in receptacles provided for such
purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
