AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON NOVEMBER 8, 1983, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE PROPOSED LA JOLLA LANDSCAPE DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ONE PROPOSITION RELATING TO APPROVING THE IMPOSITION OF A SPECIAL TAX, AND CONSOLIDATING SAID SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON NOVEMBER 8, 1983.

WHEREAS, the City Council will call a General Municipal Election in the City, in the San Diego Unified School District and in the San Diego Community College District to be held on November 8, 1983; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of San Diego, California, on November 8, 1983, and pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII A of the Constitution of the State of California and the Charter of The City of San Diego, the Council of The City of San Diego, being the legislative body thereof, hereby proposes and submits to the qualified voters of the proposed La Jolla Landscape District of the City as such District is described in a map on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 768730, at such municipal election the following:

PROPOSITION _____

Approving the imposition of a tax of \$20 per annum on each taxable unit of property located in the proposed La Jolla Landscape District to provide for landscaping improvements and maintenance within the District.

Section 2. The proposition shall be presented and printed upon the ballot and submitted to the voters in the manner and form set out in Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The polls for this Special Municipal Election shall be open at 7 a.m. (local time) on November 8, 1983, and remain open continuously until 8 p.m. (local time) on the same day at which time the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14301 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 4. Since this election is being consolidated with the General Municipal Election, and since the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass returns of this election, and since only one form of ballot is authorized, the method of voting upon the proposition shall be as provided in the Elections Code of the State of California; and, on the ballots to be used at this Special Municipal Election, in addition to any other matters required by law, there shall be printed substantially the following:

Section 5. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "YES," shall be counted in favor of the adoption of the proposition. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "NO," in the manner hereinbefore provided shall be counted against the adoption of the proposition.

Section 6. The Special Municipal Election called for November 8, 1983 in the City of San Diego is hereby ordered consolidated with the General Municipal Election to be held on the same date. Within the City of San Diego the precincts, polling places and officers of the election for the Special Municipal Election shall be the same as those provided for in the General Municipal Election.

Section 7. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election and these elections shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and within the City only one form of ballot shall be used. The Board of Supervisors shall certify the results of the canvass of the returns of this Special Municipal Election to the Council of The City of San Diego which shall then declare the results of the election.

Section 8. The proposition submitted by this ordinance shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 9. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, the Special Municipal Election shall be conducted as provided by law for other municipal elections of the City.

Section 10. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper. No other notice of the election need be given.

Section 11. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter, this ordinance relating to elections shall take effect on August 1, 1983, being the day of its introduction and passage.

WHEREAS, the City Council will call a General Municipal Election in the City, in the San Diego Unified School District and in the San Diego Community College District to be held on November 8, 1983; NOW, THEREFORE,
