Section 2. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal
Election will be held in the San Diego Unified School District
on Tuesday, November 8, 1983, for the purpose of electing the
following members of the Board of Education:

MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION for District A	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION for District D	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION for District E	four-year term

Section 3. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal
Election will be held in the San Diego Community College
District on Tuesday, November 8, 1983, for the purpose of

electing the following members of the Governing Board of Trustees:

Section 4. For the purpose of said elections, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list on consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 6. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8, 1983

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.
