AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII, ARTICLE 5, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 85.02 RELATING TO TRUCK PARKING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 5, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by amending Section 85.02 to read as follows.

SEC. 85.02 TRUCK PARKING PROHIBITED.

- A. The term "equipment," as used in this Section, shall mean and include, but without limitation, trailer, semi-trailer, pole or pipe dolly, special mobile equipment, specially constructed vehicle, reconstructed vehicle, and/or any load placed thereon.
- B. It shall be unlawful for the driver on a motor truck and/or equipment exceeding twenty-four (24) feet in length to drive the same in, or to allow such motor truck and/or equipment to remain parked within the central traffic district of The City of San Diego between the hours of 10:00 o'clock a.m. and 6:00 o'clock p.m. of any day except Sundays and holidays.
- C. It shall be unlawful for the driver, owner, or lessee, lessor, consignee or consignor of a motor truck or equipment, with a rated capacity exceeding one (1) ton to allow such truck and/or equipment to remain parked at any

time upon the following street locations:

- 1. San Ysidro Boulevard between Camino de la Plaza and Via de San Ysidro;
- 2. Via de San Ysidro from San Ysidro Boulevard to southerly terminus;
- 3. Calle Primera from Via de San Ysidro to Willow Road;
- 4. Willow Road from Calle Primera to southerly terminus:
- 5. Front Street from Willow Road to New York Avenue:
- 6. Camino de la Plaza from Willow Road to San Ysidro Boulevard:
- 7. Via Nacional from Camino de la Plaza to southerly terminus;
- 8. Louisiana Avenue from Camino de la Plaza to southerly terminus;
- 9. Virginia Avenue from Camino de la Plaza to Encinita Street:
- 10. Sycamore Road from Calle Primera to southerly terminus;
- 11. Camiones Way from Camino de la Plaza to southerly terminus; and
- 12. Willow Road from San Ysidro Boulevard to southerly terminus.
- D. It shall be unlawful for the driver, owner, lessee or lessor, consignee or consignor of a motor truck or equipment with a rated capacity exceeding one (1) ton to

park such truck and/or equipment for an excess of three (3) hours (except when loading or unloading) along the following streets:

- 1. Clairemont Mesa Boulevard from I-805 to Pocahontas Avenue; and
 - 2. Clairemont Drive.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
