## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 257910 Adopted on FEB 7 1983

WHEREAS, it is desirable to reduce the nation's energy consumption and dependence on foreign oil and extended Daylight Savings Time would provide a no-cost method for the nation to reduce its electricity consumption by an estimated one percent (1%) for the months of March and April; and

WHEREAS, a federal study has shown consistently less violent crime for periods of Daylight Savings Time when compared to similar periods of standard time; and

WHEREAS, most traffic fatalities occur at night, and extended Daylight Savings Time would provide a longer lighted period for drivers returning home from work, thus increasing traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has previously expressed its support for then pending federal legislation to extend the period of Daylight Savings Time by two months; and

WHEREAS, said legislation remained in committee and it is now necessary to reintroduce a similar bill when Congress reconvenes in January; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Council reaffirm its support for federal legislation extending the period of Daylight Savings Time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Council strongly reaffirms its support for federal legislation to extend the period of Daylight Savings Time by two months.
