SECTION 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. That THOMAS O. MEADE is hereby appointed to perform all of the duties and functions of the Superintendent of Streets as said duties are specified and designated in the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, for the above referenced Assessment District.

SECTION 3. That the place for recordation of the assessment roll and diagram shall be in the Office of the Superintendent of Streets, and said assessment roll and diagram, upon recordation, shall be kept as a permanent record.

SECTION 4. That the DAILY TRANSCRIPT is hereby designated as the newspaper for all publications as required by law and as necessary for completion of this Assessment District.

SECTION 5. That this City Council hereby establishes a special fund designated by the name and number of the Assessment District, and into said fund shall be placed all proceeds from the sale of bonds and cash collections. In order to expedite the improvements or acquisition under these proceedings and as authorized by law, funds from any available source may be transferred into said special fund. Any funds transferred are a loan to the fund and shall be repaid out of the proceeds of the sale of bonds, all as required and authorized by law, and specifically Section 10210 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
