

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 257986

Adopted on FEB 22 1983

WHEREAS, the United States Federal Government plans to construct a new International Border Crossing on Otay Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Diego have proposed to provide an interim access road to such facility; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego has applied for and will set aside or received and set aside Federal Aid Secondary (FAS) funds for its share of the access road up to a maximum of approximately 2.2 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has applied for and set aside Federal Aid Urban (FAU) funds along with appropriate City funds for the balance of the costs of the access road; and

WHEREAS, an Urban Limit Boundary map approved by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) prescribes the urban area boundary areas on Otay Mesa and thereby governs the distribution of certain federal funds; and

WHEREAS, California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) and FHWA require that FAS funds only be expended beyond the urban area boundary and FAU funds be expended only within the urban boundary; and

WHEREAS, the existing urban area boundary is south of Otay Mesa Road from State Route 117 easterly to La Media Road, which


would result in a disproportionate burden of costs and would frustrate the ability to expend FAS and FAU funds as budgeted by the City and County; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to adjust the urban boundary to match local government's available funding sources; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City and County desire CalTrans to secure approval from FHWA and SANDAG to revise the urban boundary as shown on Exhibit "A" to north of Otay Mesa Road from La Media Road westerly to the section line between SEC 33 and SEC 34 T185 RIW S.B.M.
