## DRAFT

Add Section 4450 Lentitled "Local Equivalent Procedures" to the Government Code:

## 4450.1

(a) The regulations imposed by the State Architect pursuant to Section 4450, et seq. shall not be applicable to public facilities located within the public right-of-way of a local government if that local governmental entity has an effective procedure for the design of handicap access which is comparable to the standard promulgated by the State Archi-

tect as provided in 4450.

- (b) A local agency comparable procedure shall include as a minimum a comprehensive set of design standards for handicap access in the public right-of-way maintained by local government. Exceptions and variances from these handicap access standards may be allowed in unusual situations if the local agency has an advisory body that reviews the exceptions and variances.
- This body shall also advise the local government on the comprehensive set of design standards for handicap access in the public right-of-way maintained by the local agency. The advisory body must include at least one organization representing physically handicapped persons. Handicapped/employees of the local government may serve on the advisory board but they may constitute no more than 1/3 of the total membership. Local governments may jointly form advisory bodies and adopt a uniform appeal process.
