BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with WESTEC Services, Inc. for the services of personnel to provide operation and maintenance of the Digester Gas Recovery Electrical Generating Plant and training of personnel at the Pt. Loma Treatment Plant for a 12-month period, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 258165 .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$539,400 within the Sewer Revenue Fund 41506 from Capital Improvements Project 43-118 Ocean Beach Trunk Sewer (70492) to Digester Gas Utilization Facility Operation (70227), to be used solely and exclusively for the above purpose.


