POLICY

Ballot propositions shall be placed before the electorate only at such elections which are conducted throughout the entire city. Prior to any such election, the City Clerk shall place on the docket a notice of Council consideration of ballot proposals and a notice of the last date for submittal of ballot proposals at least six weeks prior to the meeting at which the Council is required to direct the City Attorney to prepare the necessary resolutions or ordinances for the citywide election.
