RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 258430

Adopted on MAY 9 1983

WHEREAS, until passage of Proposition 13, local governments in California enjoyed considerable financial "home rule;" and

WHEREAS, included therein was the exercise of tax rate authority and receipt of various subventions from the legislature; and

WHEREAS, since Proposition 13, local revenue flexibility has been sharply reduced and the complex "bail out" to assist local government in dealing with Proposition 13 has been steadily eroded by the State's response to its own budget pressures; and

WHEREAS, it is becoming increasingly more obvious that local governments need a permanent and stable revenue base; and

WHEREAS, it is generally agreed that whatever solution is offered, it should be in the form of a constitutional amendment; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 1983, the Rules Committee considered the issue, as contained in the Intergovernmental Relations Department (IRD) Report No. 83-22, said report setting forth the various proposed constitutional amendments addressing the issue; and


WHEREAS, the Rules Committee approved the recommendation of IRD contained in the report except that it wished to take no position on ACA 38 and SCA 26, and is now seeking full Council

endorsement of two of the proposed measures and Council  
rejection of two other proposed measures; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
that this Council approves the recommendation of the Inter-  
governmental Relations Department and hereby endorses the  
concept of "Project Independence" as contained in ACA 18 and SCA  
23 and further expresses no position on ACA 38 and SCA 26, the  
specifics of which are set forth in IRD Report No. 83-22, dated  
March 30, 1983.
