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#### ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT AND FIELD SERVICE UNIT

SUBJECT: Administrative Support and Field Service

Classes included in this unit are primarily non-supervisory, white collar personnel in the clerical, field services, and related areas. As a general rule, these classifications do not require any college preparation or highly technical experience. They are not members of construction or maintenance crews, but rather, primarily work in an office or perform some quasi-clerical functions in the field. In past years, these classes have tended to move together in terms of salary, and the history of employee relations has been quite interrelated. There is a great commonality of interest, in that we find a similarity of education and experience requirements, and incumbents have been qualified for other than their own narrow field.

#### SUPERVISORY UNIT

SUBJECT: Supervisory Unit

Traditionally, supervisors are excluded from units which include their subordinates. This history is consistent, long standing, and extends even to the first level of supervision. There are a number of reasons why this is the case, the most important being that supervisors cannot be "brothers" to their subordinates and cannot represent their subordinates in grievance or other type proceedings with a conflict of interest. The classifications included are those which have significant combinations of traditional supervisory functions including assigning and directing work; supervising employees; evaluating performance; enforcing rules and standards; and planning production and service. For the most part, supervisors are not involved in the work of a crew but perform substantially different tasks the majority of their work day.

#### TECHNICAL UNIT

SUBJECT: Technical Unit

This unit is distinguished by the inclusion of classifications that require a technical, specialized knowledge or are of a non-clerical administrative nature. The community of interest is based on either a subprofessional relationship to the professional staff or technical competence in a specialized area other than in those occupational groups traditionally known as clerical or blue collar. The proposed unit includes a number of non-supervisory classifications found City-wide in a variety of occupational groupings. These classes, in large measure, have a small number of incumbents, and it is impractical to carve out a variety of units based on a narrow specialty or interest due to the time and expense which would be necessary in dealing with each one. Instead, based on past history, we have found that generally, the commonality of interest in terms of a broad technical and subprofessional interest and a similar salary movement and cohesion of representation over a number of years is a strong influencing factor.
