WHEREAS, HR 1 is presently on the House floor and appropriates \$4.5 billion in FY 84 for Community Development Block Grant to local agencies; and

WHEREAS, the House Appropriations Committee has decided that CDBG funding for FY 84 should be only \$3.47 billion because the Emergency Jobs Legislation provided \$1 billion in extra CDBG funding; and

WHEREAS, the House Appropriations Committee funding level is lower than previous years; and

WHEREAS, 60 additional cities will qualify for CDBG funds in 1984 necessitating more money to be shared by all cities; and

WHEREAS, continued allocation of sufficient CDBG funds is crucial to the City of San Diego's ability to fund important public services and capital improvement projects, particularly in the inner city, many of which are job-generating; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that our Washington, D. C. representative is instructed to support any efforts to insure the CDBG funding in Fy 84 is at the \$4.5 billion figure authorized.
