RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, MAKING DECLARATIONS AND DETERMINATIONS AS TO THE SUFFICIENCY OF CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS OF IMPROVEMENT

MAY 3 1 1983

(Assessment District No. 3990 - Lopez Canyon Sewer and Retention Basin)

WHEREAS, the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, is considering the formation of a special assessment district, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Divison 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, for the construction of certain sanitary sewer and retention basin improvements, together with appurtenances and appurtenant work, said special assessment district to be known and designated as

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 3990 (LOPEZ CANYON SEWER AND RETENTION BASIN)

(hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"); and,

WHEREAS, said special assessment district proceedings include the construction and installation of certain retention basin and storm water control improvements, as said improvements are shown on the previously approved plans and specifications for said Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, the California Coastal Commission has imposed certain conditions for drainage requirements on undeveloped land and properties within their jurisdiction, said properties being within the Lopez Canyon Drainage Basin; and,

WHEREAS, the City does hereby declare, find and determine that the proposed retention basin and storm water control improvements, as proposed for the above-referenced Assessment District and as shown on the plans and specifications, do satisfy the requirements as they relate to those lands within the Assessment District lying within the drainage basin of said Lopez Canyon.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the retention basin and storm water control improvement project as proposed for the Assessment District satisfies the Coastal Commission requirements for drainage, and properties within the drainage basin within the Assessment District should be allowed to develop without any further or additional Coastal Commission requirements relating to storm water control and runoff control.

SECTION 3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the California Coastal Commission, and approval or ratification is hereby requested from said Coastal Commission as to the declarations and determinations as set forth in this Resolution.
