RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF SIGNS AND ADVERTISING DISPLAYS.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has enacted an interim emergency ordinance providing for the use of signs and advertising displays without limitation on the content of messages expressed thereon except for ground signs; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is intended to provide for interim regulation pending the consideration of a permanent program of regulation developed through public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the interim ordinance shall expire in 120 days; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to conduct hearings for the purpose of obtaining public comment on proposals for amending the City-wide On-Premises Sign Regulations to incorporate provisions which would remove limitations on the messages that such signs may display and such other proposals as may be developed through the public hearing process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Planning Commission is directed to provide the City Council with a report and recommendations in a timely manner that will enable the City Council to act on the report and recommendations within the time frame provided by the interim emergency ordinance.
