WHEREAS, on June 8, 1983 the Public Services and Safety Committee discussed the growing problem of drug and alcohol abuse and the feasibility of a City/County approach to the problem and referred the matter to the City Manager for a report; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager issued Report No. 83-288 dated July 7, 1983 to the Public Services and Safety Committee concerning the subject: "Task Force on Teenage Drug and Alcohol Abuse," recommending that a Task Force be established under the auspices of the City Council, the County Board of Supervisors and the City and County Boards of Education; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 1983 the Public Services and Safety
Committee discussed the matter of solutions to teenage drug and
alcohol abuse and unanimously approved the City Manager's
recommendation to establish a Task Force on Teenage Drug and
Alcohol Abuse; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that a Task Force on Teenage Drug and Alcohol Abuse is hereby established to consist of two elected representatives from each of the following governmental bodies:

- 1. San Diego City Council.
- 2. San Diego County Board of Supervisors.
- 3. San Diego Unified School District Board of Education.
 - 4. San Diego County Board of Education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors and the City and County Boards of Education are requested to participate on the Task Force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Task Force goals should include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1. Reduce the incidents of drug/alcohol abuse through the development and implementation of a comprehensive, regional program of prevention and education with a focus on youth.
- 2. Provide leadership and direction in the problem assessment, planning, program development and evaluation required to create and implement an effective strategy.
- 3. Development of public policy to support Task Force activities.
- 4. Provide maximum coordination between and among agencies.
- 5. Development of community financial support for programs to move away from the total dependence on public monies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Councilmembers Bill Mitchell and William Jones are appointed as the representatives of the City Council on the Task Force and Councilmember Mike Gotch is appointed alternate representative.
