WHEREAS, JAY GUEDALIA and JAMES C. MARTINEZ, partnership, Owner, filed an application under Hillside Review Permit No. 83-0110 to construct a 12-unit condominium project supported on columns above grade on an 0.36 acre site located on the south side of Montecito Way, between Goldfinch and Falcon Streets, in the R-3 (HR) Zone, within the boundaries of the Uptown Community Plan, and described as Lots 1-6 and portions of Lots 23 and 24, Block 345, Arnold and Choate's Addition, Map No. 334; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 1983, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its finding of facts, granted said Hillside Review Permit No. 83-0110, subject to conditions, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 1983, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0454 of the San Diego Municipal Code, JOHN M. LOMAC, JR. appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on August 2, 1983, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of the Municipal Code, Section 101.0454, to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any determination of the Planning Commission, subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the

Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Hillside Review Permit No. 83-0110:

- 1. The Council believes that the proposed development will not result in minimum disturbance of the natural terrain commensurate with the proposed use.
- 2. Proposed grading and excavation of this project will result in soil erosion, silting or lower slopes slide damage.
- 3. The proposed development will not preserve and enhance the natural environment by maintaining the existing topography of the site.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of JOHN M. LOMAC, JR. is granted; the decision of the Planning Commission to deny the appeal is overruled, and said Hillside Review Permit No. 83-0110 is hereby denied.
