
WHEREAS, the Deukmejian Administration is formulating a plan to guarantee cities and counties a larger share of state sales tax revenues in exchange for shifting responsibility for some state programs to local government; and

WHEREAS, cities and counties already receive revenue from one cent of the six cents sales tax; and

WHEREAS, under this proposed plan, local government's share of the state sales tax would go to two cents; and

WHEREAS, cities and counties would be willing to return over a billion dollars a year in state subventions in exchange for the additional one cent sales tax; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council urges that the General Assembly of the League of California Cities assembled in annual conference in San Francisco, October 5, 1983, express and declare League support for legislation that would eliminate all subventions by establishing a single identifiable source of revenue consisting



of an additional one cent of sales tax from the existing six cent sales tax levy, to be appropriated for and used exclusively by local agencies.
