RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SAN DIEGO STADIUM AUTHORITY AWARDING \$9,155,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF SAN DIEGO STADIUM AUTHORITY REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 1983 OF SAID AUTHORITY TO THE BEST BIDDER AND REJECTING ALL OTHER BIDS

WHEREAS, at the time and place fixed for the opening bids for the \$9,155,000 bonds of the San Diego Stadium Authority, San Diego, California, designated "San Diego Stadium Authority Revenue Bonds" ("Bonds"), and numbered R-l to R-1831, inclusive, all bids were publicly opened, examined and read by the Secretary hereof, and a tabulation thereof has been presented to this Governing, Board and entered into the minutes; and
