RESOLUTION OF FEASIBILITY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CITY HEIGHTS BLOCK GRANT STREETS AND ALLEYS - CONTRACT NO. II.

WHEREAS, the hearings provided for in Resolution of Intention No. R-259022 have been held at the time and place fixed, and all continuances, if any, were duly made and ordered; and

WHEREAS, at said hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully considered and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to the proposed improvement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Except for Alley Block One, Bungalow Park
Addition, Map No. 1175 and Alley Block 89, Amended City
Heights Map No. 1007, written protests or objections
against the proposed improvement have not been made by the
owners of more than one-half of the area of the land
included within the assessment district or of the area of
property to be assessed, and except for Alley Block One,
Bungalow Park Addition, Map No. 1175 and Alley Block 89,
Amended City Heights Map No. 1007, each and all oral and
written protests and objections, if any, made or filed in
the matter are hereby overruled and denied. With respect

to Alley Block One, Bungalow Park Addition, Map No. 1175 and Alley Block 89, Amended City Heights, Map No. 1007, the protests and objections are hereby sustained, and they are hereby deleted from this assessment district. The area described in the Resolution of Intention is hereby revised to delete those areas.

2. The proposed improvement within the now revised limits mentioned in Resolution of Intention No. R-259022 is hereby determined to be feasible and that the lands to be assessed therefor will be able to carry the burden of such proposed assessment, and that the public convenience and necessity require the proposed improvement, and that the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 shall not apply.
