RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND IN THE SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 8, 1983.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held in the City of San Diego, the San Diego Unified School District, and the San Diego Community College District on Tuesday, November 8, 1983, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-16053 (New Series), for the purpose of electing candidates; and

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-16017 (New Series) and Ordinance No. O-16018 (New Series), adopted August 1, 1983, which special municipal election was consolidated with the general municipal election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego three propositions, as follows:

PROPOSITION A

PROPOSITION A. ADVISORY VOTE ONLY.

Shall the City enter into an agreement with the San Diego Unified Port District which provides that the Port shall build a convention and exhibition center on Port-owned land at Port expense using available Port District funds; and further provides that the City shall operate and maintain this center, provided that the cost to the City for operating and maintaining the center shall be paid only from revenues derived from operation of the center itself and, if necessary, from Transient Occupancy Tax revenues derived from occupancy of hotels within the Navy Field Complex?

PROPOSITION B

PROPOSITION B. CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT.
ADDS SECTION 76.1.

Amends the Charter relating to special taxes to conform to Article XIII(A) of the California Constitution by providing that a special tax may be levied by the City Council only if approved by a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors of the City or if the special tax is to be levied upon less than the entire City only if approved by a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors in the area of the City in which the tax is to be levied.

PROPOSITION C

PROPOSITION C. APPROVAL OF IMPOSITION OF TAX IN
PROPOSED LA JOLLA LANDSCAPE DISTRICT.

Approving the imposition of a tax of \$20 per annum on each taxable unit of property located in the proposed La Jolla Landscape District to provide for landscaping improvements and maintenance within the District.

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the general municipal election and the special municipal election, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of these elections has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

I

The whole number of votes cast in the City was 169,504.

II

The whole number of votes cast in the San Diego Unified School District was 152,629.

III

The whole number of votes cast in the San Diego Community College District was 152,629.

IV

The total vote received by each municipal candidate and each candidate for the Board of Education of the San Diego Unified School District and each candidate for the Governing Board of Trustees of the San Diego Community College District at the general municipal election is as follows:

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND IN THE SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 9, 1983.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held in the City of San Diego, the San Diego Unified School District, and the San Diego Community College District on Tuesday, November 9, 1983, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-18063 (New Series), for the purpose of electing candidates; and

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-18017 (New Series) and Ordinance No. O-18018 (New Series), adopted August 1, 1983, which special municipal election was consolidated with the general municipal election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego these propositions, as follows:

PROPOSITION A

PROPOSITION A. ADVISORY VOTE ONLY.

Shall the City enter into an agreement with the San Diego Unified Port District which provides that the Port shall build a convention and exhibition center on Port-owned land at Port expense using available Port District funds; and further provides that the City shall operate and maintain this center, provided that the cost to the City for operating and maintaining the center shall be paid only from revenues derived from operation of the center itself and, if necessary, from Transient Occupancy Tax revenues derived from occupancy of hotels within the Navy Field Complex?

Amend the Charter relating to special taxes to conform to Article XX(A) of the California Constitution by providing that a special tax may be levied by the City Council only if approved by a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors of the City or if the special tax is to be levied upon less than the entire City only if approved by a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors in the area of the City in which the tax is to be levied.
