WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements by City Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owner has requested the vacation of that portion of Union Street adjacent to Lots 3-6, Block 82, of Middletown; Maple Canyon Road in Lots 3-5, 10, and a portion of Lot 6, Block 82, a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown, and a portion of Lot I, Block 292, of Horton's Addition; Horton Avenue adjacent to Lots G-I and a portion of Lot J, Block 292, of Horton's Addition, Lot 10, Block 82, and a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown; and Curlew Street adjacent to Lots A and B, Block 291, and Lots K and L, Block 292, all of Horton's Addition, to facilitate the marketing of the property; and

WHEREAS, those portions of Horton Avenue adjacent to G-I, Block 292, of Horton's Addition, and Union Street adjacent to Lots 3-6, Block 82, of Middletown, are excess rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Maple Canyon Road in Lots 3-5, 10, and a portion of Lot 6, Block 82, and a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown, and in Lots J-L and a portion of Lot I, Block 292,

of Horton's Addition; Horton Avenue adjacent to a portion of Lot J, Block 292, of Horton's Addition, a portion of Block 83, and Lot 10, Block 82, all of Middletown; and Curlew Street adjacent to Lots K and L, Block 292, and Lots A and B, Block 291, all of Horton's Addition, have been impassable for vehicular traffic and have had no public money expended for their maintenance for a period of five consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, those rights-of-way to be vacated are no longer needed for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the streets to be vacated through will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the portion of Union Street adjacent to Lots 2-6, Block 12, of Middletown; Maple Canyon Road in Lots 3-5, 10, and a portion of Lot 6, Block 82, a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown, and a portion of Lot I, Block 292, of Horton's Addition; Horton Avenue adjacent to Lots G-I and a portion of Lot J, Block 292, of Horton's Addition, Lot 10, Block 82, and a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown; and Curlew Street adjacent to Lots A and B, Block 291, and Lots K and L, Block 292, all of Horton's Addition, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 20644-D, on file in the office of the City Clerk as

259645 -

Document No. RR-\_\_\_\_, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

- 2. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, sewer and general utilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines.
- 3. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead

or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above-described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.

- 4. That the easements reserved herein are in, under, over, upon, along, and across Union Street adjacent to Lots 3-6, Block 82, of Middletown; Horton Avenue adjacent to Lots G-I, a portion of Lot J, Block 292, of Horton's Addition, and Lot 10, Block 82, and a portion of Block 83, all of Middletown; and Curlew Street adjacent to Lots A and B, Block 291, and Lots K and L, Block 292, all of Horton's Addition, vacated by this document and as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 20644-D, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 259645.
- 5. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until an Engineering Permit to construct public improvements within the right-of-way has been issued.
- 6. That this resolution shall not become effective unless and until a Parcel Map (TM 82-0587) has been approved.
- 7. That in the event either or both of the above conditions cannot be met by October 1, 1988, this resolution shall become void and be of no further force or effect.
- 8. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the issuance of the aforementioned Engineering Permit and the approval of the aforementioned Parcel Map, and that the City

Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.










