WHEREAS, Clara E. Breed began her career with the San Diego Public Library in 1928 as the Children's Librarian and gave forty-two years of distinguished professional library services to the citizens of San Diego, from 1928 to 1970; and

WHEREAS, Clara E. Breed served as City Librarian for twenty-five of those years, during a period when the Central Library and 17 of the City's 29 branch libraries were constructed; and

WHEREAS, she was a founder of the Serra Cooperative Library System, which serves public library systems in San Diego and Imperial Counties; and

WHEREAS, Clara E. Breed has continued, since her retirement, to serve the best interests of the San Diego Public Library, including the writing of an impressive history of that institution which she served so well entitled "Turning the Pages"; and


