AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION
IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, June 5,
1984.

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that commencing with the year 1984 the elections to the offices of Mayor and City Attorney shall be held every four (4) years, and that the Municipal Primary Election for these offices shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on January 30, 1984 the City Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R- 260029 requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego to order the consolidation of the Municipal Primary Election to be held on June 5, 1984 with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 5, 1984, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MAYOR	four-year term
CITY ATTORNEY	four-year term

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 1984.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
