SEC. 33.3511 EXEMPTIONS

First paragraph, (a), (b), (c) and (d) - No change.

(e) Holistic health practitioners are nonmedical health care therapists who use a massage specialty and therapeutic approach in caring for clients and who present to the Chief of Police proof of satisfactory completion of one thousand hours of instruction in such specialty or therapeutic approach at a school with a State accredited curriculum and proof of membership in a State or nationally chartered organization devoted to the specialty or therapeutic approach. The practice of such health care therapists may include other services such as nutritional assistance of counseling as long as all activities are directed toward health care.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
