ORDINANCE NUMBER O- **16178** (New Series)

Adopted on MAR 12 1984

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING A PORTION OF PUEBLO LOT 1302, MISCELLANEOUS MAP NO. 36, (2.51 ACRES), LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF CARGILL AVENUE, BETWEEN NOBEL DRIVE AND DECORO STREET, IN THE UNIVERSITY NORTH COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-1000 ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0410 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 13456, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 15, 1932, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that within three years of the effective date of this ordinance a portion of Pueblo Lot 1302, Miscellaneous Map No. 36, (2.51 acres), located on the west side of Cargill Avenue, between Nobel Drive and Decoro Street, in the University North Community Plan area, in the City of San Diego, California, designated "R-1000" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3629, is subdivided and a map or maps thereof duly submitted to the City and thereafter recorded, and within such subdivision or subdivisions provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 101.0410 shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land, and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into R-1000 Zone, as described and defined by Section 101.0410, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated

on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3629, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 768860. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the map as provided in this section.

Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 13456, adopted February 15, 1932 be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-18878 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT OFFICER; EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT OFFICER FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE CLASSIFICATION OF LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT OFFICER; AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance to establish a new position entitled "Library Development Officer," exempts the position from the Classified Service and places it in the Unclassified Category of Management D, with a salary range of 7.3 and 7.4 attached thereto. The newly created position will replace the existing position of Library Fundraiser/ Volunteer Coordinator which is classified as a Senior Librarian.
