AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-15976 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1983-84" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF PARAMEDIC COORDINATOR; EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF PARAMEDIC COORDINATOR FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE CLASSIFICATION OF PARAMEDIC COORDINATOR; AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Personnel Department conducted a study of the proposal to establish a new position, entitled "Paramedic Coordinator" and recommended the position be created to replace the present Paramedic Coordinator which is currently performed by an Associate Analyst; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager concurs in such action and recommends creation of said position; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that the new classification of Paramedic Coordinator meets those qualifications and definitions and should be designated as unclassified; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed this

request on April 5, 1984, and has commented favorably to the Council upon the requested exemption from the classified service of said classification; and

WHEREAS, a review of this classification indicates the nature and duties of the position are consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter section 117(a)17; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that this position be established and exempted from the Classified Service pursuant to the Charter provisions; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to effectuate said creation and exemption and establishment of compensation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-15976 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1983-84" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of Paramedic Coordinator.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission on April 5, 1984, the position of Paramedic Coordinator is hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 15976 (New Series) be,

and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said positon designation in the Unclassified Service.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position is hereby authorized and designated to be placed in Managerial Classification Range of Managerial B with Salary Range 7.3 and 7.4 attached thereto.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
