ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16233 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 1, OF  
THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION  
21.04 RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as  
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 1 of the San Diego  
Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by amending Section  
21.04 to read as follows:

SEC. 21.04 HOLIDAYS

Except where otherwise specifically defined and  
provided in this Code, the holidays in The City of San  
Diego are:

- (a) January 1st;
- (b) Third Monday in January, known as "Dr. Martin  
Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday";
- (c) Third Monday in February, known as "Washington's  
Birthday";
- (d) Last Monday in May, known as "Memorial Day";
- (e) July 4th;
- (f) First Monday in September, known as "Labor Day";
- (g) November 11th, known as "Veteran's Day";
- (h) Fourth Thursday in November, known as  
"Thanksgiving Day";
- (i) December 25th; and

(j) Every day appointed by the City Council for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday.

(k) A floating holiday to be requested by the employee and approved by the appointing authority in accordance with provisions of the Personnel Manual of The City of San Diego.

If January 1st, July 4th, November 11th or December 25th fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday, and if they fall on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
