AN ORDINANCE CALLING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, November 6, 1984.

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that commencing with the year 1984 the election to the office of Mayor shall be held every four (4) years, and that the General Municipal Election for this office shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State General Election; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on July 23, 1984 the City

Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R
261236 requesting the Board of Supervisors of the

County of San Diego to order the consolidation of the General

Municipal Election to be held on November 6, 1984 with the

Statewide General Election to be held on the same date; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, November 6, 1984, for the purpose of electing a Mayor for a four-year term.

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that

certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 6, 1984.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
