AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON NOVEMBER 6, 1984, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ONE PROPOSITION RELATING TO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE FROM THE SALK INSTITUTE FOR BIOLOGICAL STUDIES (SALK) OF A PORTION OF PUEBLO LOT 1324 CONSISTING OF 2.57 ACRES OF SALK PROPERTY TO BE ADDED TO TORREY PINES CITY PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE IN ADDITION OF \$350,000.00 TO BE USED FOR PARK ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENTS, IN EXCHANGE FOR A CONVEYANCE BY THE CITY TO SALK OF 2.3 ACRES OF DEDICATED TORREY PINES CITY PARK LAND NOW USED AND TO BE USED BY SALK FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES AND ONE PROPOSITION RELATING TO AN ADVISORY MEASURE IN CONNECTION WITH THE NAME OF SAN DIEGO JACK MURPHY STADIUM.

WHEREAS, the City Council will call a General Municipal Election in the City, to be held on November 6, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on July 23, 1984, the City Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No.

R-261236 requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego to order the consolidation of a special municipal election to be held on November 6, 1984, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of San Diego, California, on November 6, 1984, and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 55

and 219 of the Charter of The City of San Diego and the provisions of Section 5353 of the California Elections Code, the Council of The City of San Diego, being the legislative body thereof, hereby proposes and submits to the qualified voters of the City at such special municipal election the following propositions:

Ratification of Ordinance No. 0-16248 (New Series) authorizing the acceptance from the Salk Institute for Biological Studies (Salk) of a portion of Pueblo Lot 1324 consisting of 2.57 acres of Salk property to be added to Torrey Pines City Park and authorizing the acceptance in addition of \$350,000.00 to be used for park acquisition and improvements, in exchange for a conveyance by the City to Salk of 2.3 acres of dedicated Torrey Pines City Park Land now used and to be used by Salk for research purposes.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE FROM THE SALK INSTITUTE FOR BIOLOGICAL STUDIES (SALK) OF A PORTION OF PUEBLO LOT 1324 CONSISTING OF 2.57 ACRES OF SALK PROPERTY TO BE ADDED TO TORREY PINES CITY PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE IN ADDITION OF \$350,000.00 TO BE USED FOR PARK ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENTS, IN EXCHANGE FOR A CONVEYANCE BY THE CITY TO SALK OF 2.3 ACRES OF DEDICATED TORREY PINES CITY PARK LAND NOW USED AND TO BE USED BY SALK FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That The City of San Diego is hereby authorized to convey to The Salk Institute for Biological Studies the following described pueblo lands presently dedicated for park purposes as a part of Torrey Pines City Park:

Approximately 2.3 acres of Pueblo Lot 1324 of the Pueblo Lands of The City of San Diego identified as Parcel One on Exhibit A attached hereto,

to be used for the purpose of research in biology, the cause, prevention and cure of disease, and for such other purposes as may be approved by the Council of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That the authorization for such conveyance shall be subject to the following conditions:

(a) That The Salk Institute for Biological Studies shall convey to The City of San Diego the following described pueblo lands:

Approximately 2.57 acres of Pueblo Lot 1324 identified as Parcel Two on Exhibit A attached hereto,

to be dedicated by said City of San Diego for park purposes as a part of Torrey Pines City Park; and

(b) The Salk Institute for Biological Studies shall pay to The City of San Diego the sum of \$350,000.00, which sum shall be used for park acquisition and improvement.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective only after it is affirmatively approved by a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors of The City of San Diego voting at the general election to be held in said City on the 6th day of November, 1984, at which time such proposition of ratifying this ordinance is submitted.

Shall the name of the City's stadium be changed back from "SAN DIEGO JACK MURPHY STADIUM" to "SAN DIEGO STADIUM"?

Section 2. The propositions shall be presented and printed upon the ballot and submitted to the voters in the manner and form set out in Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The polls for this Special Municipal Election shall be open at 7 a.m. (local time) on November 6, 1984, and remain open continuously until 8 p.m. (local time) on the same day at which time the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14301 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 4. Since this election is being consolidated with the statewide general election, and since the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass returns of this election, and since only one form of ballot is authorized, the method of voting upon these propositions shall be as provided in the Elections Code of the State of California; and, on the ballots to be used at this Special Municipal Election, in

addition to any other matters required by law, there shall be printed substantially the following:

Section 5. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "YES," shall be counted in favor of the adoption of the proposition. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "NO," in the manner hereinbefore provided shall be counted against the adoption of the proposition.

Section 6. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election and these elections shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and within the City only one form of ballot shall be used. The Board of Supervisors

shall certify the results of the canvass of the returns of this Special Municipal Election to the Council of The City of San Diego which shall then declare the results of the election.

Section 7. The propositions submitted by this ordinance shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 8. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, the Special Municipal Election shall be conducted as provided by law for other municipal elections of the City.

Section 9. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper. No other notice of the election need be given.

Section 10. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter, this ordinance relating to elections shall take effect on JUL 23 1984, being the day of its introduction and passage.
