

ORDINANCE NUMBER O-16262 (New Series)

Adopted on AUG 14 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16249 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY EXEMPTING TWO (2) DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITIONS IN THE WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT (700) FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 117; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department (700) was authorized two (2) Deputy Director positions, one each in the Services Division (706) and in the Water Quality Division (703); and

WHEREAS, those positions are an integral part of a comprehensive organizational plan for the Department as proposed by the Price Waterhouse Organization study; and

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department requested the exemption from the Classified Service of those two (2) Deputy Director positions which are authorized in its personnel allocation as a result of said organization study; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on June 7, 1984 and has commented favorably upon the exemptions as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said exemptions from the Classified Service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. 00-16249-1, as adopted and amended therein, by authorizing the exemption from the Classified Service of two (2) Deputy Director positions in the Water Utilities Department (700), one (1) each in the Services Division (706) and Water Quality Division (703), said positions currently authorized as shown in the personnel authorization of the Water Utilities Department (700), said positions to be placed in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed on June 7, 1984, and commented favorably upon the request for exemption of said positions from the Classified Service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified positions, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.7 and 7.8 of the Table of Classifications and Standard

Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 16214 (New Series), dated May 29, 1984, be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

Utilities Department for fiscal year 1984-85. This ordinance also  
establishes a rate of compensation for the unclassified positions.
