

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16273 (New Series)

Adopted on AUG 20 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 11, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 101.1112 AND 101.1113, AND BY ADDING SECTIONS 101.1114.1, 101.1115.1, 101.1117.2 AND 101.1118.3, RELATING TO ON-PREMISES SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 11, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 101.1112 and 101.1113, and by adding Sections 101.1114.1, 101.1115.1, 101.1117.2 and 101.1118.3, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.1112 GROUND SIGNS (FREESTANDING)

A., B., C., D., E., F., G., H., I., J., K. and

L. - No changes.

M. COASTAL ZONE REGULATIONS

Within the Coastal Zone, the following regulations shall be supplementary to, and in the event of conflict shall supersede, the regulations set forth or referenced in preceding paragraphs of this Section.

1. Number and size permitted. The requirements of Paragraph "A." shall apply except that the maximum permitted area of each sign shall comply with Subparagraph "4." below, and in

no case shall such area exceed a maximum of 100 square feet per face.

2. More than one frontage. The requirements of Paragraph "B." shall apply except that the maximum permitted area shall comply with Subparagraph "4.", below.

3. Height Limit. No ground sign may exceed a height of eight feet as measured vertically from the base at ground level to the apex of the sign.

4. Area. The requirements of Table 1, Paragraph "D." shall apply except that in no case shall the maximum permitted area exceed 100 square feet per face.

5. Residential proximity. The provisions of Paragraph "F." shall apply except that no sign shall exceed a height of eight feet.

6. Rotating and projecting signs. Rotating signs and signs which project over roofs and public rights-of-way shall not be permitted.

SEC. 101.1113 WALL SIGNS

A., B., C., D., E., F. and G. - No changes.

H. COASTAL ZONE REGULATIONS

Within the Coastal Zone, the following regulations shall be supplementary to, and in the

event of conflict shall supersede, the regulations set forth or referenced in preceding paragraphs of this Section.

1. Area. The provisions of Paragraph "A." shall apply except that the permitted sign area shall not exceed 1.0 square foot for every linear foot of street frontage of each tenant, and provided that each tenant shall be permitted a minimum sign area of 15 square feet.

2. Mansard walls, or roofs. The provisions of Paragraph "C." shall apply except that the maximum amount of sign area shall not be greater than 50 percent of the area allowed in Subparagraph "1.," above.

3. Projecting wall signs. Projecting wall signs shall not be permitted.

SEC. 101.1114.1 ROOF SIGNS PROHIBITED IN COASTAL ZONE

Within the Coastal Zone, roof signs shall not be permitted.

SEC. 101.1115.1 PROJECTING SIGNS PROHIBITED IN COASTAL ZONE

Within the Coastal Zone, projecting signs shall not be permitted.

SEC. 101.1117.2 ROTATING AND REVOLVING SIGNS PROHIBITED IN COASTAL ZONE

Within the Coastal Zone, rotating and revolving signs shall not be permitted.


SEC. 101.1118.3 MARQUEES OTHER THAN THEATER
PROHIBITED IN COASTAL ZONE

Within the Coastal Zone, marquees other than
theater marquees shall not be permitted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
