AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 102.0411, RELATING TO SOILS AND GEOLOGIC REPORTS, AND BY ADDING SECTION 102.0411.1, RELATING TO GEOLOGIC REPORTS WITHIN THE COASTAL ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 2, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 102.0411, and by adding Section 102.0411.1, to read as follows:

SEC. 102.0411 SOILS AND GEOLOGIC REPORTS

A preliminary soils report is required for all subdivisions and a more detailed soils investigation may be required by the City Engineer under the conditions described in Chapter 4, Article 7 of the Subdivision Map Act. The requirement for a preliminary soils report may be waived by the City Engineer after a determination that additional information regarding soils of the subdivision is not needed.

In addition to the requirement for a preliminary soils report, a geological reconnaissance report that addresses potential geologic hazards may be required. Where unstable conditions are indicated, the City Engineer may require that these findings be addressed in a final engineering

geology report. The final engineering geology report, including specific mitigation measures, shall be incorporated in the detailed construction plans as a condition of final map or final parcel map approval.

SEC. 102.0411.1 GEOLOGIC REPORTS - COASTAL ZONE

Within the Coastal Zone, a geological reconnaissance report shall be required for any subdivision proposed to be located wholly or in part within a "moderate" (C), "high" (D), or "variable" (BC or AC) Risk Zone as identified on the geotechnical land use capability maps referenced by the Seismic Safety Element of the General Plan, and on file in the office of the City Engineer. The geological reconnaissance report shall be prepared in accordance with the Engineering and Development Department's "Guidelines for Geotechnical Reports," and shall be submitted with the tentative map or the tentative parcel map; and shall be considered and made available for public review as part of the standard environmental review process.

Where unstable conditions are indicated, the City Engineer shall make a determination regarding the need for a preliminary engineering geology report. The decision of the City Engineer shall be based on a review of presently available data relating to the geology of the site, including but not limited to the geologic reconnaissance report, prior soils or geologic reports in the immediate area, existing literature, and field test data. Where it is determined that a preliminary engineering geology report is required, the report shall include the results of

limited subsurface investigations sufficient to identify, in a general manner, the nature and magnitude of such unstable conditions; and shall identify alternative mitigation measures that may be needed. The preliminary engineering geology report shall be submitted and reviewed by the City Engineer prior to approval of the tentative map or the tentative parcel map. Submission of a final engineering geology report shall be required as a condition of final map or final parcel map approval.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
