AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16249 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY EXEMPTING ONE (1) DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION IN THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, SOLID WASTE DIVISION (533) FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 117; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized a Deputy Director position in the Fiscal Year 1984-85 budget to act as Chief of Disposal pursuant to a study and reorganization of the Solid Waste Division; and

WHEREAS, the General Services Department requested the exemption from the Classified Service of this Deputy Director position which is authorized in its personnel allocation as a result of said organization study; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that
"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for
formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"
may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon
first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil
Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on April 5, 1984 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and PAGE 1 OF 3

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said exemption from the Classified Service; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-16249 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. 00-16249-1, as adopted and amended therein, by authorizing the exemption from the Classified Service of one (1) Deputy Director position in the General Services Department, Solid Waste Division (533), said position currently authorized as shown in the personnel authorization of said Department and Division, said position to be placed in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed on April 5, 1984, and commented favorably upon the request for exemption of said position from the Classified Service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rate 7.8 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 16214 (New Series), dated May 29, 1984, be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
