AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1,

HEARING RESPONSIBILITY FOR MULTIPLE PERMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 101.0225 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0225 CONSOLIDATION OF PUBLIC HEARING  
RESPONSIBILITY FOR MULTIPLE PERMITS

Applications for any discretionary permit requested or required in conjunction with other permits or variances requiring discretionary action by more than one decision-making authority or body shall be heard by the senior granting authority or body.

The findings for each permit shall be considered individually; however, for the purpose of the discretionary action, these multiple permits shall constitute one project.

The hierarchy in terms of seniority is as follows:


1. City Council.
2. Planning Commission.
3. Planning Director or Subdivision Board.
4. Zoning Administrator.


