AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING SECTION 102.0310, RELATING TO EXPIRATION OF TENTATIVE MAPS..

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 2, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 102.0310, to read as follows:

SEC. 102.0310 TENTATIVE MAPS - EXPIRATION

Expiration and time extension of approved or conditionally approved tentative maps or tentative parcel maps shall be in accordance with Chapter 3, Articles 2 and 3 of the Subdivision Map Act; provided, however, that the time for expiration of the initial approval may be any term not less than 24, nor more than 36 months. Extensions of time may be granted provided the applicant complies with the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 2 of the Subdivision Map Act. An extention of time within which a final map must be filed may be granted to provide a maximum period of 72 months from the date of initial approval.

SEC. 102.0310 TENTATIVE MAPS - EXPIRATION

Expiration and time extension of approved or conditionally approved: tentative maps or tentative parcel maps shall be in accordance with Chapter 3, Articles 2 and 3 of the Subdivision Map Act, provided, however, that the time for expiration of the initial approvalmay be any term not less, than 24, nor more than 36 months: Extensions of time may be granted provided the applicant compiles with the pravisions of Chapter 3, Article 2 of the Subdivision Map Act, An extension, to time within which a final map must be filed may be granted to provide a maximum period of 72 months from the date of initial approval.
