

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16295 (New Series)

ADOPTED ON OCT 2 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16249 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING SECTION 2.II. THEREOF TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION 35 ENTITLED, "HILLCREST PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FUND (10565)" TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, approved formation of the Hillcrest Parking and Business Improvement District (BID) on June 12, 1984, and it was officially established on July 26, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Hillcrest BID is proposed to strengthen the business and living environment of the Hillcrest business areas of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Fiscal Year 1985 operating budget for the Hillcrest BID is \$40,000.00, said amount based on the revenue which will be generated from a special assessment on business in the area; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to include the necessary language for establishment of a Hillcrest Parking and Business Improvement District Fund; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 00-16249-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending Section 2.II. thereof to add a new subsection 35, entitled "HILLCREST PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FUND (10565)," to read as follows:

35. HILLCREST PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT (10565)	
Non-Personnel Expense	\$ 40,000.00

Any monies deposited in the Hillcrest Parking and Business Improvement District Fund in excess of estimated revenue and any carry-over monies from the previous fiscal year are hereby appropriated for the purposes for which said fund was created.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17, and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
