ADOPTED ON OCT 23 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16249 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY TRANSFERRING FROM THE GENERAL FUND (100), POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC SERVICES (11510) TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL GROWTH FUND (10505), LITTER CONTROL PROGRAM (93225) 1.0 SUPERVISING FIELD REPRESENTATIVE POSITION, 4.0 FIELD REPRESENTATIVE POSITIONS, WAGES AND SALARIES FOR SAID POSITIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,315, AND NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSE FUNDS IN THE SUM OF \$71,452.

WHEREAS, prior to 1973, the responsibility for processing the removal of abandoned vehicles from both public and private property resided with the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, during that year the County of San Diego took over vehicle abatement on private property under a State Vehicle Abatement Program provided by Senate Bill 1308 (1971) and continued through 1978 at which time changes in the definition of certain abatement processes made continued County participation in the program uneconomical; and

WHEREAS, in late 1980, the City took over vehicle abatement from private property, this time administered by the Litter Control Program of the General Services Department and throughout this period, the responsibility for vehicle abatement from public property continued to reside with the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, during the City Council's FY 1985 budget review, the City Manager was requested to consider the benefits of consolidating vehicle abatement responsibility within one department; and

WHEREAS, the FY 1985 budget includes \$58,702 and 1.50 positions in the General Services Department (funded in the Environmental Growth Fund) and \$131,767 and 5.00 positions in the Police Department (funded in the General Fund); and

WHEREAS, because of constraints placed on General Fund growth by Proposition J, it is not recommended that positions be transferred into General Fund, but rather, it is recommended that the consolidated program be budgeted in the Environmental Growth Fund; and

WHEREAS, in FY 1985, this can be accomplished by transferring the monies currently included in the Police Department's budget to the Environmental Growth Fund; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16249-1, as amended and adopted therein, by transferring from the General Fund (100), Police Department Traffic Services (11510) to the Environmental Growth Fund (10505), Litter Control Program (93225) the following positions: 1.00 Supervising Field Representative; 4.0 Field Representatives.


Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer from the General Fund (100), Police Department Traffic Services (11510) to the Environmental Growth Fund (10505), Litter Control Program (93225) the following sums in connection with the transfer of personnel directed in Section 1 above:

Wages and Salaries	\$ 60,315
Non-Personnel Expenses	71,452
TOTAL	<u>\$131,767</u>

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

O-16349 (NEW SERIES), ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-16349-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY TRANSFERRING FROM THE GENERAL FUND (100), POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC SERVICES (11510) TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL GROWTH FUND (10206), LITTER CONTROL PROGRAM (33226) 1.0 SUPERVISING FIELD REPRESENTATIVE POSITION, 4.0 FIELD REPRESENTATIVE POSITIONS, WAGES AND SALARIES FOR SAID POSITIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,916, AND NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSE FUNDS IN THE SUM OF \$71,452.

This ordinance amends the budget to transfer five (5) from the Police Department Traffic Services to the Environmental Growth Fund Litter Control Program for the purpose of consolidating litter control of abandoned vehicles from both private and public property. The positions transferred are 1.00 Supervising Field Representative and 4.00 Field Representatives. This ordinance also transfers the appropriate sum for wages and salaries and non-personnel expenses.
