ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16320 (New Series)

ADOPTED ON NOV 5 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16214 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULED OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" BY AMENDING EXHIBITS A AND B THERETO TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS MANAGER AND ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, prior to January 1, 1984, telephone service was a regulated monopoly, and Pacific Telephone, as a sole source, provided the many telephone management services required by the City; and

WHEREAS, with deregulation of the telephone system, the City Charter requires that the City advertise for bids for telecommunications services and equipment; and, as a result, it is necessary to have a City employee with technical and managerial expertise to administer the City's telecommunication systems program; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no City classification which encompasses the specialized knowledges in telecommunications systems required of this position and, as a result, the Civil Service Commission, at its September 6, 1984 meeting, approved a recommendation to create a new classification of Telecommunication Systems Manager with a monthly salary range of approximately \$2,722 - \$3,296; and

WHEREAS, this salary level is consistent with that paid by other public agencies for similar positions and is also appropriate based on internal salary relationships; and

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that the new class of Telecommunications Systems Manager be eligible for Regular Rate Overtime under the same conditions as other professional classifications; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Exhibit B thereto to create and establish the classified position of Telecommunications Systems Manager.

Section 2. As a schedule of compensation for the position created in Section 1 above, the following standard rate number of the Tables of Classes and Standard Rates is hereby established and adopted.

Telecommunications Systems Manager	94.8

Section 3. The position of Telecommunications Systems Manager shall be inserted in Exhibit B to Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, under the general category of Management, Fiscal and Staff in front of the position of Rate Analyst.


Section 4. The Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to amend, as necessary, Exhibit A to Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, by calculating and inserting in said Base Salary Table, the following new rate:

<u>RATE</u>	<u>RANGE (STEP A-E)</u>
94.8	\$2,722 - \$3,296 (monthly)

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, the above newly created position, with the concurrence of the Civil Service Commission and City Manager, shall be and is hereby designated to be eligible for regular rate overtime. The Personnel Director is hereby directed to include such designation in the Personnel Manual of The City of San Diego.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12814 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" BY AMENDING EXHIBITS A AND B THEREOF TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS MANAGER AND ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance to establish a new position entitled "Telecommunications Systems Manager" and places it in the Classified Service under the category of Management, Fiscal and Staff. It also establishes a salary range for said position including pay for Regular Rate Overtime provided other professional classifications.
