WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 254787, the City Council of The City of San Diego established the Residential Permit Parking Area A; and

WHEREAS, the residents of an area adjacent to Area A have petitioned the City to evaluate their area for an expansion of Residential Permit Parking Area A; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has conducted a study of the parking problems in the area adjacent to Area A; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the City Manager indicated that legal onstreet vehicle parking places were almost totally occupied during the period from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the City Manager indicated that approximately 65% of the vehicles parked on the streets in the proposed study area were not registered at addresses within the study area; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the City Manager indicated that the number of registered vehicles within the area exceeds the total number of offstreet spaces available by a ratio of 1.5 to 1.0; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's survey has indicated that a residential permit parking system would alleviate the current parking problems if nonresidents were not permitted to park within the studied residential area; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 1983, the City Manager conducted a public hearing in the proposed Residential Permit Parking Area to receive information regarding the desire and need of the residents for residential permit parking; and

WHEREAS, in the petition requesting the implementation of a residential permit parking system in the hearing conducted as a result of its submission, the necessity for a parking prohibition was discussed; and

WHEREAS, the area adjacent to Area A could be annexed to and become a part of Residential Permit Parking Area A and be managed under the same terms and conditions without an excessive additional burden on the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, based upon the City Manager's survey and resident's petition, a parking prohibition in the area adjacent to Area A would be effective; and

WHEREAS, the testimony of the area residents at the public hearing indicated unanimous support for parking prohibition as the appropriate means of reducing noise, air pollution and neighborhood congestion created by the excessive number of commuter vehicles using the streets of their neighborhood; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the area delineated on the document attached hereto as Attachment 1 be and it is hereby added to Residential Permit Parking Area A.

- 2. That on or after the effective date of this resolution, the City Manager is directed to erect appropriate signs in the expanded Residential Permit Parking Area A indicating prominently thereon the parking prohibition, the period of time of its application and the conditions of exemption therefrom.
- 3. That the enforcement of this resolution shall be valid upon the placement of signs in the expanded Residential Permit Parking Area A.
