

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-260015

Adopted on January 24, 1984

WHEREAS, the International Boundary and Water Commission ("IBWC") has heretofore proceeded to divert sewage flowing into the United States from the Republic of Mexico across the International Boundary into a holding pond constructed by the IBWC on IBWC property; and

WHEREAS, the IBWC has proposed to pump or otherwise transport the diverted sewage from the pond to the City's wastewater treatment facility on Point Loma by connecting the pond to the existing emergency line operated by the City of San Diego which presently connects the Mexican sewage system to the San Diego Metropolitan Sewage System ("Metro System"); and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that two to three million gallons per day (mgd) will be diverted into the Metro System and therefore treated at City facilities under this project at a cost of approximately \$438.00 for each one mgd plus associated maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, a question has arisen of whether said project will cause degradation of the water quality of underground water supply; and


WHEREAS, said project is located in an area subject to flooding and inundation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed and authorized to permit the IBWC to connect to the City as aforesaid in accordance with the following specific

conditions:

1. That the City incur no cost as a result of this project including, but not necessarily limited to, construction, maintenance or sewage treatment;
2. That said connection be limited to 120 days;
3. That IBWC consider installation of protective devices to eliminate degradation of the water quality, such as a plastic liner for the pond;
4. That the City be held harmless and indemnified for and from any monetary loss as a result of this project; and
5. That written understandings with respect to the above-stated conditions be duly executed by the appropriate agencies.
