RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ORDERING REORGANIZATION, "LOWER MISSION GORGE REORGANIZATION."

WHEREAS, pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code, preliminary proceedings for reorganization consisting of two changes of organization, being an annexation to The City of San Diego and a detachment from the San Diego County Flood Control District - Zone 2, were initiated by The City of San Diego by filing on August 23, 1983, a resolution of application (Resolution No. R-258887) with the Local Agency Formation Commission in the County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the executive officer of the Local Agency
Formation Commission has filed a report relative to said
proposed reorganization, which report has been reviewed and
considered by the Local Agency Formation Commission; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 1983, the Local Agency Formation Commission Resolution No. RO83-12 (attached hereto as Exhibit 1), approved the proposed reorganization and authorized the Council of The City of San Diego to initiate and conduct proceedings for the proposed reorganization in compliance with Resolution No. RO83-12 and pursuant to Government Code Section 56000 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the Resolution of Approval, No. RO83-12, from the Local Agency Formation Commission, this

Council on December 12, 1983, pursuant to Government Code
Section 56430, adopted Resolution No. R-259792 which initiated
proceedings to reorganize by making changes of organization
consisting of the annexation of territory to the City of San
Diego and the detachment of territory from the San Diego County
Flood Control District - Zone 2, pursuant to the provisions of
the District Reorganization Act of 1965 and in conformance with
the terms and conditions set forth by the Local Agency Formation
Commission in Resolution No. R083-12; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-259792 also directed the City Clerk of The City of San Diego to set a public hearing for the proposed reorganization, which was scheduled to be held on Tuesday, January 24, 1984, at the hour of 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers, 12th Floor, City Administration Building, 202 "C" Street, San Diego, California, and also directed the City Clerk to give notice of the hearing in the manner provided by the District Reorganization Act of 1965; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the affidavit of publication and the certificate of posting and mailing are on file in the office of the City Clerk; that required notice was duly and properly given; that this is the time and place for the hearing; that the Local Agency Formation Commission's resolution making determinations has been read aloud or summarized; that all persons desiring to be heard have been heard; and that testimony and evidence for or against the proposed reorganization have been considered in accordance with Government Code Section 56435.

- 2. That no exclusions of land from the proposed annexations or detachments were requested or made.
- 3. That no written protests of the proposed reorganization were filed with the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that each of the changes in organization contained in the proposal for reorganization is ordered pursuant to Government Code Section 56439(c). The changes of organization consist of:

- 1. Annexation of the territory described in Exhibit A, which is attached to Exhibit 1, to The City of San Diego.
- 2. Detachment of the territory described in Exhibit A, which is attached to Exhibit 1, from the San Diego County Flood Control District - Zone 2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to send the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of San Diego six certified copies of the resolution approving the boundary change and six copies of the legal description of the boundaries.

- 3. State Board of Equalization fee in the amount of 3\_\_300.0.

  (make checks payable to "State Foard of Equalization".

  NOTE: Filings received in the LAFO: office after November 15 and to be filed by December 31 must include an affittional 10%, as required by Section 3(6) of the State Deard of Equalization Schedule of Processing Fees effective January 1, 1961.

The ExecutiveOfficer will check all documents for compliance before filings are made. Amendments to the LAFOU resolution, including boundary modifications, can only be made by the Commission. All documents recorded and dopies of letters of acknowledgment will be returned to the conducting authority.

WHEREAS, a resolution of application was submitted to this Commission for reorganization of territory including annexation to the City of San Diego and detachment from the San Diego County Flood Control District - Zone 2, which resolution was adopted by the City Council of the City of San Diego as Resolution No. 259897, pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965 (Government Code Section 56000, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed for reorganization is as described in the application on file with the Local Agency Formation Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 56262, the Executive Officer of this Commission set a public hearing on the proposed reorganization for November 7, 1983, and gave notice of the date, time, and place of said hearing in accordance with Government Code Sections 56264 and 56265; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer of the Commission has filed his report on said reorganization, which report was received and considered by the Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Commission hereby finds, determines, and orders as follows:

- (1) The hearing was held on the date set therefor, and due notice of said hearing was given in the manner required by law.
- (2) At that hearing the Commission called for, heard, and considered all interested parties and read and considered the report of the Executive Officer.
- (3) The Commission certifies that the determination by the City of San Diego that this reorganization is exempted by State CECA Guidelines Section 15360 from the requirements of CECA has been reviewed and considered.
- (4) The Commission certifies, provident to Suvernment Cole Section 54774.3, that this proposal was a make no effect on any agricultural preserves as defined in a symmetofice Section (i. ..a) and would not result in the conversion of conversional agricultural laws to nonagricultural use.


