BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego proposes and intends to enter into an amended agreement with the State of California to order the following work to be done and improvements to be made for a freeway in said City under the provisions of section 100.2 and 100.22 of the California Streets and Highways Code.

DESCRIPTION OF AGREEMENT

The proposed agreement amends the agreement dated October 3, 1963 relating to that portion of State Highway Route 15 from 2.9 miles north of Miramar Road to Sunset Drive by the provision of an interchange at North City Parkway and other changes. A full and complete copy of the proposed agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR- 260271 for public review.
