WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission has proposed that City-owned Sites 15A, 344, 355, 374, 491, 646 and 647 be utilized for development of up to 70 two-bedroom, one-bath rental units by the Baker/Walsh Partnership; and

WHEREAS, twenty percent (20%) of the units in the project will be available to and occupied by moderate income households; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined after due consideration that there is a need to provide additional affordable rental opportunities within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the utilization of Sites 15A, 344, 355, 374, 491, 646 and 647 for housing has been previously approved by the City's Transportation and Land Use Committee; and

WHEREAS, development and ongoing monitoring of the proposed sites will be facilitated through administration of the sites by the San Diego Housing Commission; and

WHEREAS, Site 355 was originally acquired using State Gas Tax funds; and

WHEREAS, construction of residential units on Site 355 cannot occur prior to reimbursement to the $\hat{\text{Gas}}$ Tax Fund of the full fair market value of the site; and

WHEREAS, the City established the Low Income Housing
Capital Outlay Fund No. 30249 on July 20, 1977 by Resolution No.
218880 to enhance the financial feasibility of low and moderate

income housing developments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to release up to \$75,000 from the Low Income Housing Capital Outlay Fund No. 30249 and to use said funds to reimburse the State Gas Tax Fund for the acquisition of Site 355.
- 2. The Housing Commission is hereby directed to initiate the processing required to utilize \$75,000 from its 1983 or 1984 Community Development Block Grant allocation to reimburse the Low Income Housing Capital Outlay Fund No. 30249 for acquisition of Site 355.
- 3. The Housing Commission is hereby directed to return to the City Council for approval an Administration Agreement between the City and the Housing Commission which will delegate to the Housing Commission all necessary authority to perform the ongoing monitoring and administrative functions regarding the Option and Lease Agreements for Sites 15A, 344, 355, 374, 491, 646 and 647.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the Option and Lease Agreements in substantially the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

 P26367, for the specific purpose of the development and operation of up to 70 rental housing units by the Baker/Walsh Partnership, twenty percent (20%) of said units to be occupied by moderate income tenants.

5. Disposition of any revenues derived by the Housing Commission through its administration of leases on these sites shall be referred to the joint City Council/Housing Commission Task Force, and that said Task Force shall make a recommendation as to the use of such revenues to the full City Council.
