Dear Mr. Blair:

Refer to my letter of January 31, 1984.

This is to request a 30-day extension of the permit to discharge Tijuana sewage from the emergency regulating pond to the San Diego Metropolitan Sewage System with the understanding that the same conditions would apply as were in effect for the first 60 days of operation, namely:

- There will be no construction, operation or maintenance costs to the City of San Diego as a result of the emergency regulating pond.
- 2. This agency will reimburse the City at the rate of \$431.17/mg for the cost of treating the sewage discharged from the emergency regulating pond to the Metro System.
- 3. The Federal Government cannot hold the City harmless and idemnify for any monetary loss as a result of the regulating pond.
- 4. The permit will be limited to 30 days, with the understanding that any proposal for extension would be subject to approval by the City.

The reason for the requested extension is that although it is expected that Mexico will fully resume operation of the Tijuana disposal system within the next 10 days, which would eliminate the

need for the emergency regulating pond, your approval of the extension is requested for the next 30 days in the event the pond is needed. We will advise your office as soon as there is no longer a need for the pond.

The City's favorable and early consideration of this request will be appreciated.
